

**College of Architecture 2006-2007 Scholarships  
(Awarded in the Spring 2008 Semester)**

**Boardman Architecture Honor Fellowship (1st Year undergraduate only)**

Criteria: 1) Demonstrate academic excellence, (minimum 3.0 GPA), 2) Demonstrate financial need, 3) Undergraduate students, 4) Selection based on quality of Design Studio performance, overall architectural studies performance, and general university studies performance.

Typical Award Amount: \$1,000

**Brick Southeast Student Scholarship**

Criteria: 1) Graduate student, 2) Recipient must be enrolled in good standing, 3) Recipient must demonstrate innovative and design excellence.

Typical Award Amount: \$2,500.

**Daniel and Alice Forest Scholarship**

Criteria : 1) First year student, 2) Merit based, 3) Student must demonstrate ability for creativity and originality.

Typical Award Amount: \$1,000.

**FreemanWhite Scholarship for Architectural Studies**

Criteria : 1) Architecture major, 2) Rising fourth year undergraduate or rising second year graduate student in good standing with the College of Architecture. (**Notes:** Award may be renewed as long as recipient meets criteria and remains in good standing. Recipient may also be provided an intership at FreemanWhite, Inc., however; this is not a requirement for award acceptance.)

Typical Award Amount: \$2,500.

**Ghost Scholarship**

Criteria: The CoA may send two students (typically one undergraduate and one graduate) to participate in the innovative design-build experience known as GHOST, a summer program offered in Nova Scotia, Canada, by architect Brian MacKay-Lyons. The application process is open to all graduate and undergraduate students (preference is given to rising fourth or fifth year students).

Typical Award Amount: two scholarships at \$750 each.

**VLM International Study Scholarship**

Criteria : 1) Graduate student of the College of Architecture who plans to participate in ARCH 7110 (one of the international study programs sponsored by the CoA), 2) Financial need or merit based.

Typical Award Amount: \$1,000 (spring award for summer studies).
